



# THE LADY WITH THE LAMP

## “The Lady with the Lamp”

Here’s how to make your own lantern!

What you will need:

- A4 paper
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Stapler

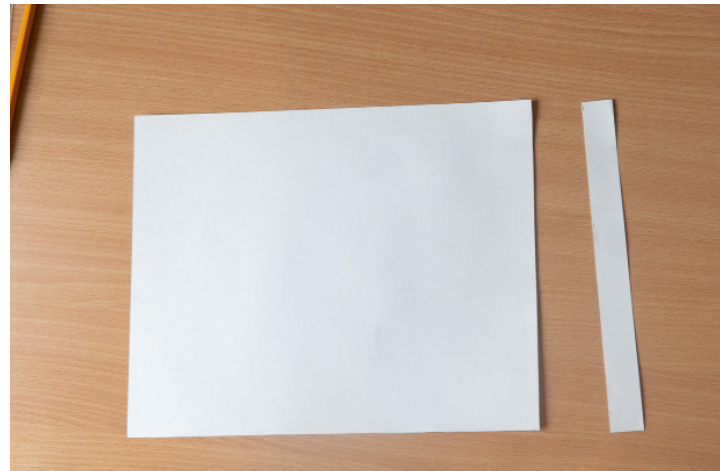


# HOW TO MAKE:

## FLORENCE NIGHTINGALE TURKISH STYLE LAMP

### Step 1:

Select your A4 paper. You can use white or coloured paper.  
Cut a strip of paper 2cm wide from one end of the paper. This will make the handle later, so keep it safe!  
Fold the sheet of the paper in half lengthwise.



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## FLORENCE NIGHTINGALE TURKISH STYLE LAMP

### Step 2:

With the folded edge on the left, draw a line 2cm in from the right hand edge. Make marks every 2 cm along this line, then draw lines at each mark down to the folded edge.

Cut along these lines from the folded edge to the original marked line. Cut through both layers of paper, then open the paper flat.

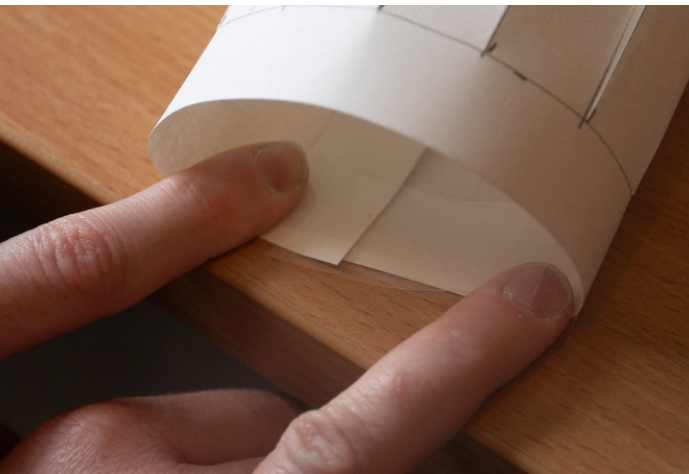


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### Step 3:

Bring the edges together in a cylindrical shape with the cut strips running vertically. Be sure that the fold is on the outside of the lantern. Tape or staple the edges together at the top, middle, and bottom.



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## FLORENCE NIGHTINGALE TURKISH STYLE LAMP

### Step 4:

Take the strip that you cut off in step 1, and attach one end of it to the top of lantern with tape or staples. Then curl it over and attach the other end to make a handle. The lantern will stand on its own.
