MARVELLOUS HISTORY DBS POLICY

Marvellous History visitors are one-off visitors to the school, who are not carrying out a regulated activity and do not expect to be left in charge of children unsupervised in any circumstances.

This means that according to the <u>Government guidelines</u> on safeguarding in schools, Marvellous History visitors are not required to hold a DBS certificate.

For your peace of mind, all of our office staff and visitors **do** hold advanced DBS certificates **and** participate in regular safeguarding training.

The school has no right, however, to request sight of a visitor's full DBS certificate.

All our office staff and visitors are issued with a Marvellous History ID Card. The MH ID card confirms their DBS status by displaying the DBS certificate number.
